Dear Friends,

We often hear about having God in our hearts. Perhaps you became a Christian by inviting Jesus into your heart. It is a wonderful (and rather mind blowing) truth that God makes us his home. Just pause for a moment and notice that God is with you now.

The corresponding wonder, which is perhaps less often heard, is that we are invited also to live in God; to make God out home.

In John 15, Jesus extends the invitation to abide, to live, to be, in Jesus.

⁵“I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit.

Our Christian life is as much about living in Jesus as it is Jesus living in us. What difference does it make to you to picture yourself in Jesus heart?

It is from this, and only this place that we then bear fruit. We might think of the Fruits of the Spirit (see Galatians 5:22-23)), or other evidence of life and growth, or seeing God’s Kingdom grow. But always, it begins, and is, love.

⁹“As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love.

Spend some time with this. Ask God to show you how much he loves you, and what it means to him and to you that you are in his heart.
